John Powell: You tried to convince Beth that keeping Kiefer was just the wrong move? Why didn't she see that and what do you predict will happen now?

Tina Thistle: "I think the reason why she wanted to keep Kiefer is I think Kiefer promised her a final three deal and based on his competition wins she felt that he could probably potentially bring her further. What is that going to do to her game? I think what's going to happen is Kiefer is going to band together with Tera and Braydon and if one of them get HoH then I think Beth could be in trouble."
