





John Powell: How you feeling after everything?

John Powell: When it came to comps you didn't do very well. I think the biggest thing is that because of your background, I mean talked about playing for the CFL, people thought your would have done better. What happened out there?

Then, I got cut so then I inevitably had to come back home and revert to physical therapy. My time with the Elks was short but I did love my time in the CFL. The game is so much different than back here in America and me playing the position of wide receiver. It is tailored to my game. So, I love the CFL. It sucks that I got injured and I got cut but I think I would have had a very prosperous year and career there.

John Powell: Do you wish you would have campaigned a little bit more to Makensy or do you think you said everything you had to say?

Cam Sullivan-Brown: I think I campaigned very hard the week before to get Makensy to see the benefits of keeping me and the the negatives of picking Chelsie for the final two. As the week went on in the house, when we were the final three, I just knew their relationship was too close. Makensy felt way too comfortable in the house and at that point I knew that there was really nothing that I could say to sway Mackensy. She was always going to try to use the loyalty pitch to her advantage and not backing down from a threat. John Powell: After Zingbot's comments to Chelsie though you did pivot your game did you not?





John Powell: Your story could very much turn into a redemption arc in the future. Would you come back and play again?

Cam Sullivan-Brown: I would play again. Big Brother is such a unique experience and me being able to have a second go at it I think I would do so well. The thing that I would do different, oh, it's no secret. I would want to win some competitions. That's basically it. I can have some power and have some moves that I can stand on and say that it was me being at HoH and me doing this and getting this person specifically out. I would love to play Big Brother again. I love this game. This game is so cool. This game is so unique and it tests you in so many different ways. I would love to come back.


