I always really felt close to Ava and Kelley as well. We just sort of gravitated towards each other and that was a group that I also felt loyal to as well.

Lauren Domingue: Yeah, this is a hard one. I think if I had to choose I would probably choose Keanu just because I know he's such a competitive threat. I do think that if he doesn't go then there is a good chance that he wins his way to the end because he is such a great competitive threat.
